

2006 General Meeting Motions

MOTION #2006.1: SEPARID to contribute \$250 to fund a lawyer.

Motion passed.

Training budget for CDI is \$11,000 (approx); looking for grants, etc, and will charge students a minimal amount, but need money from chapters to get started. Looking for \$1000 contribution from SEPARID.

MOTION #2006.2: SEPARID will join PARID and it's districts to support CDI training to be held across the state with a contribution of \$1000.

Motion passed.

- Professional Development: Eve West recommends that the professional development committee be reinstated. Denise Kirby and Jen Janney will try to start one. Eve West, Becky Nice, and Adrienne Carwheel will help. The PDC will offer mini-workshops before general meetings.
- Mentoring: Adrienne Carwheel sent out information about what is done in CA – bridging the gap – to help students after graduate from program, preparing for certification, preparing to work, etc. There are people who have completed the Master/Mentor program. Mark (Pittsburgh) is offering mentoring in that area; there are plans to take it statewide.
- Becky Nice recommended ID badges for student interns. Eve will look into it and see if CCP can make them.

Motion #2006.03: K. Staller/B. Smith- I move that SEPARID solicit ideas for a new logo.

MOTION DENIED

Motion #2006.4: B. Smith/K. Staller- That SEPARID add to the policies and procedures that interpreting students and ITP students all introduce themselves to each other at the start of general meetings.
